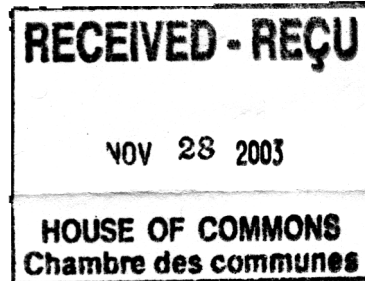

Dear Mr. Young:

This letter is further to your request received October 24, 2003, filed under the *Access to Information Act*.

As per stated in my previous letter dated October 24, 2002, copies of reports showing the number of short-term and long-term Authorizations to Transport (ATT) that have been issued, refused and revoked for each province and territory will be released to you. The report will be released to you separately, short-term and long-term, as per your request. As per stated in our telephone conversation, we are unable to produce the information requested for (2) and (3) as it relates to enforcement issues. The information you are seeking is held at various enforcement departments.

I am pleased to enclose all documents (1 page) relevant to your request. It is released in its entirety.

These represent the ATT data by jurisdiction, short term/long term for approved, refused and revoked for the calendar year 2002. The data for previous years could not be broken down by these categories. The aggregate figures are available in the Report on the Administration of the Firearms Act to the Solicitor General by the Registrar for the years 1999 to 2001.
